YMCA SPORTS COMPLEX UPDATE

DONOR FUNDING PROGRAM UNDERWAY



The YMCA of North Central Ohio has initiated its Donor Funding Program for the \$22 million Sports Complex to be built on 35 acres at Interstate 71 and State Route 97. The complex, which will include indoor and outdoor sports fields, will feature a 100,000-square-foot

building to be constructed in 2024 and ready for action in 2025. This complex in southern Richland County will become the Y's third branch, with the other two in Mansfield and Shelby.

The Sports Complex building will have a fitness center, arcade, indoor soccer, volleyball, basketball, pickleball, and walking track, while outdoors, the Y will have seven sports fields and a walking trail. The Y's new Sports Complex is expected to bring in more than \$8 million annually in retail sales and taxes for Richland County and will host multi-state soccer tournaments.

It also will be a sports training and competition facility for local children and offer other traditional Y programming.


