YMCA SPORTS COMPLEX UPDATE

OFFICIAL GROUNDBREAKING JUNE 12



June 12 was a monumental day for the YMCA of North Central OH. The celebration, which included our local elected officials, stakeholders, and YMCA enthusiasts, kicked off the build of the \$22 million Sports Complex in Bellville, OH. The new complex, which is expected to open in late 2025 or early 2026, will provide traditional YMCA programming

with indoor and outdoor athletic fields, basketball, volleyball, pickleball, indoor track, and an outdoor walking trail.

The late Jim Gorman donated 35 acres of land near the intersection of Interstate 71 and Ohio 97 to the YMCA when the board began looking for land for its third branch in Richland County.

"Today marks a significant milestone in our commitment to promote community development, wellness, and youth engagement in Richland County and North Central Ohio," said Cristen Gilbert, CEO of the YMCA of North Central Ohio. "It's not just another facility, it's a state-of-theart sports complex that combines our YMCA programming and fitness with a diverse range of activities that cater to all ages and fitness levels."

The YMCA's capital campaign has raised \$9 million after a recent \$500,000 gift from the Milliron Foundation and additional donations from Ted and Heidi Sazdanoff, Park National Bank, Mechanics Bank, and others. The campaign operates in stages, with a financial goal of \$12 million by mid-summer and a goal of \$15 million by the end of 2024.

The public campaign is now underway, and the YMCA is seeking donations from individuals, businesses, and organizations to help reach its target.

SID HALL COMPETES IN 27TH YMCA NATIONAL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS



Sid Hall competed in his 27th YMCA National Swimming Championships in Fort Lauderdale, Florida on May 12th. At 88 years young, Sid finished in the top 3 in all 6 events he competed in.

In 1986, Sid was a Mansfield Y member but hadn't swam since high school. He saw an article in the Mansfield News Journal about someone competing in the Senior Olympics which sparked his interest to swim again.

You needed to be 55 to compete, so for the next 5 years, he kept that article on his desk and began swimming again at the Y. In 1991, Sid was finally able to compete, and since then, he has been ranked in the top 10 in the country in his age division in multiple events, which includes 2 world records and 3 national records.

Sid has been involved with the Y for over 80 years. He said, " I could not have achieved any of the swimming accomplishments without the Y facilities and staff, and you are never too old to start trying something new."


